INFORMATION ONLY

WHEREAS, "A Land and Water Resource Management Plan for Racine County: 2013-2022," addresses each of Racine County's unique natural resources and identifies particular problems associated with the resource base;

WHEREAS, said plan establishes a method to help protect and restore these land resources;

WHEREAS, said plan meets the minimum State non-point source pollution reduction standards related to agricultural and non-agricultural lands;

WHEREAS, the Land Conservation Committee, through the Economic Development and Land Use Planning Committee, has been authorized to develop a revised Land and Water Resource Management Plan, which will maintain and/or improve conservation program efforts in Racine County, allowing the County to remain eligible for state program grant funding; and

WHEREAS, said plan will be used as a guide for Racine County through the year 2022 in carrying out its natural resource related programs.
