23 **WHEREAS**, Racine County has been notified that it is eligible for grant funds from
24 the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety Seat Belt
25 Enforcement in the amount of \$25,000.00; and

27 **WHEREAS**, this grant involves detection and apprehension of drivers who fail to
28 buckle their seat belts; and

30 **WHEREAS**, 50% of grant funded deployments must take place between the hours
31 of 6:00 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. during the mandatory deployment periods; and

34 **WHEREAS**, there is a 25% local match requirement for this grant which will be
35 satisfied by the use of regular duty enforcement and mileage costs expended on grant
36 activities.
