3 RESOLUTION BY THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND LAND USE PLANNING
4 COMMITTEE RECOMMENDING ADOPTION OF THE SOUTHEASTERN WISCONSIN
5 REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION (SEWRPC) AMENDMENT TO THE NATURAL
6 AREAS AND CRITICAL SPECIES HABITAT PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN
7 FOR THE SOUTHEASTERN WISCONSIN REGION

9 To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

11 WHEREAS, a comprehensive inventory of "natural areas" and "critical species
12 habitat sites" in the Southeastern Wisconsin Region was completed by the Southeastern
13 Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC) in 1994, identifying significant
14 remaining natural areas and other areas vital to the maintenance of endangered,
15 threatened, and rare plant and animal species in the Region, which was subsequently
16 adopted in 1997 by the SEWRPC;

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 66.1001(4)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the
19 Racine County Board of Supervisors formally adopted the document entitled *SEWRPC*
20 *Community Assistance Planning Report No. 301, A Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive*
21 *Plan for Racine County: 2035* on October 13, 2009;

23 WHEREAS, the aforementioned natural areas and critical species habitat sites are
24 identified and illustrated in Chapter III of the Multi-Jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for
25 Racine County: 2035;

27 WHEREAS, the SEWRPC has prepared and adopted at its meeting held on
28 December 1, 2010, an amendment to the Natural Areas and Critical Species Habitat
29 Protection and Management Plan for the Southeastern Wisconsin Region with data as
30 recent as 2008;

33 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that
34 the *SEWRPC Amendment to the Natural Areas and Critical Species Habitat Protection and*
35 *Management Plan for the Southeastern Wisconsin Region* is hereby adopted. A copy of
36 said report is on file with the County Clerk and with the Racine County Planning and
37 Development Department.

39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the
40 Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit certified copies of this resolution to all
41 municipal clerks and to the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission within
42 seven (7) days after this resolution is adopted.
