RESOLUTION BY THE RACINE COUNTY SPECIAL COMMITTEE REGARDING REAPPORTIONMENT ADOPTING A TENTATIVE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT PLAN

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the County Board of Supervisors adopts a tentative supervisory district plan establishing the number of county board districts at 21 with each district being represented by one supervisor as set forth in the map titled "21 District Substitute Draft". The map is on file with the Racine County Clerk, and is attached hereto, in a summarized format, as Exhibit "A".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the districts, their population, the average percentage of deviation of all proposed supervisory districts from the norm or theoretical ideal average, and demographic information as to each district, are set forth in Exhibit "B", also attached hereto and incorporated herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that this tentative plan is adopted pursuant to Section 59.10(3)(b)1., Wis. Stats., and that the County Clerk is directed to send a copy of this resolution and exhibits and copy of the "21 District Substitute Draft", to all municipalities within Racine County as required by Section 59.03(3)(b)1., Wis.Stats.

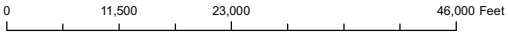
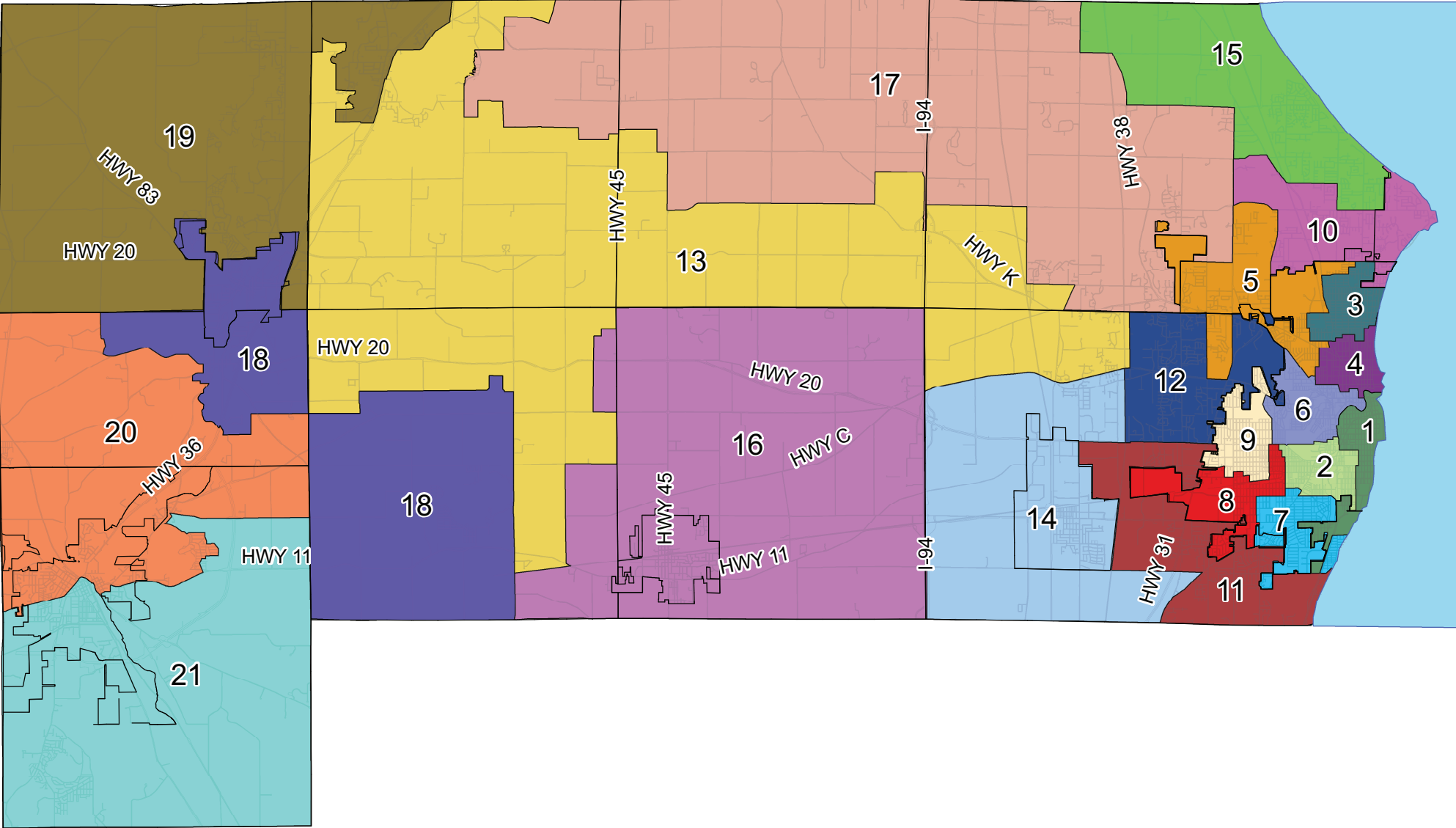
