WHEREAS, Racine County currently owns 1138 Racine Street and 1420 Marquette Street which are In Rem properties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Racine has expressed an interest in acquiring the property at 1420 Marquette Street to demolish the structure and combine the lot with the already owned City lot at 1422 Marquette Street and then deed 10 foot strips of land on the north and south sides of the newly created lot to the abutting owners for increased side yards and then build a new home for an owner-occupant on the remainder; and

WHEREAS, the City of Racine has expressed an interest in acquiring the property at 1138 Racine Street to deed it to Habitat for Humanity for a rehabilitation project next summer; and

WHEREAS, these properties are In Rem properties that will be put back into private ownership and put back on the tax rolls benefitting both the City of Racine and Racine County; and

WHEREAS, currently the back taxes for the properties including taxes, specials, interest and penalties are:

1138 Racine Street: \$20,877.29

1420 Marquette Street \$22,058.74

WHEREAS, the City of Racine has agreed to facilitate this transfer by reimbursing Racine County the following special assessments and inspection fees for each of the properties:

1138 Racine Street \$10,613.90 – Specials

\$ 100.00 – Snow inspection fees

1420 Marquette Street \$ 6,491.72

WHEREAS, the Office of Corporation Counsel and the Treasurer's Office have reviewed this matter and recommend the transfer of these properties to the City of Racine based upon the reimbursement to Racine County for the specials and inspection fees.
