RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE RACINE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF WISCONSIN AND PARTICIPATE IN THE 2010 WISCONSIN WINS UNDERAGE TOBACCO SALE REDUCTION PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT'S 2010 BUDGET

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Sheriff's Department is hereby authorized to participate in the Wisconsin WINS Underage Tobacco Sale Reduction Program with the Caledonia and Western Racine County by executing a Memorandum of Understanding with Kenosha County which is the lead agency for the multi-jurisdictional KRW Tri-County Tobacco Free Coalition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfers set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto and incorporated herein are authorized and approved within the Sheriff's Department's 2010 budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Board Chairman and/or the County Executive are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

24 **WHEREAS**, the Kenosha County Division of Health has entered into an agreement
25 with the State Department of Health Services to implement the Wisconsin WINS Program
26 whereby Kenosha is the lead agency for the multi-jurisdictional KRW Tri-County Tobacco
27 Free Coalition; and

29 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Sheriff's Department has been asked to subcontract
30 and to deploy elements of the WINS program in Caledonia and Western Racine County;

33 **WHEREAS**, the City of Racine and the Villages of Mt. Pleasant and Sturtevant will
34 also be participating in the program; and

36 **WHEREAS**, the program involves deputies working with underage individuals from
37 15-17 years old who will participate in the compliance checks at various licensed
38 establishments in Caledonia and Western Racine County; and

40 **WHEREAS**, the grant calls for 63 tobacco compliance investigations in the target
41 areas at a reimbursement rate of \$40.00 per compliance check which will generate a
42 maximum of \$2,520.00 for the department.
