IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,572.00 FROM THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, BUREAU OF TRANSPORTATION SAFETY AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$20,715.00 WITHIN THE RACINE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT'S 2010 BUDGET

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Sheriff's Department is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a 2010 Highway Safety grant for Youth Alcohol Enforcement Project 2010 - Comprehensive Alcohol Risk Reduction (C.A.R.D.) in the amount of \$16,572.00 from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds as set forth in Exhibit "A," that is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is authorized and approved within the Sheriff's Department's 2010 budget.
