8 **WHEREAS**, The Ridgewood Care Center service driveway and freight apron
9 exclusively serves Ridgewood's day-to-day need for motor-truck deliveries of essential
10 supplies and services; and,
11

12 **WHEREAS**, Both the aforementioned service driveway and freight apron have
13 carried the steady stream of heavy delivery traffic since the Ridgewood facility opened
14 more than twenty-four years ago; and,
15

16 **WHEREAS**, Wear on the driveway and freight apron begins to compromise the
17 suitable delivery of said supplies and services; and,
18

19 **WHEREAS**, The proposed rehabilitation project will replace the deteriorated
20 asphaltic pavement and concrete freight apron: Driveway replacement involves the
21 pulverization, grading, and repaving of approximately 2200 square yards of asphaltic
22 surface. Freight apron replacement involves the removal, grading, and repaving of
23 approximately 290 square yards of Portland cement concrete surface; and,

25 **WHEREAS**, Ridgewood Care Center currently budgets \$82,000.00 for the
26 aforementioned project. Yet, Ridgewood requires \$22,000 in additional funds to complete
27 this important rehabilitation.
