RESOLUTION BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDING ADOPTION OF THE WMWI METRO LANDFILL FACILITY GREENSPACE PROTECTION AND LIMITED LANDFILL EXPANSION AGREEMENT

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

WHEREAS, on or about February 28, 2003, Waste Management of Wisconsin (the "Operator") began negotiations for the siting process to expand the Waste Management of Wisconsin Metro Landfill in the host City of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, throughout the duration of the more than seven years of siting negotiations, Racine County participated on the Local Committee (also known as the Waste Facility Siting Committee created under Wis. Stat. 289.33); and

WHEREAS, Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility is owned by Waste Management of Wisconsin, Inc. and is located within the area with geographic boundaries of West Oakwood Road to the north, South 112th Street to the east, West County Line Road (8 Mile Road) to the south, and US Highway 45 to the west, all in the City of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, Racine County, the Town of Norway and the Town of Raymond are parties to the negotiations for siting a landfill expansion, as Affected Municipalities in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement arises out of, and is related to, an expansion of the Metro Recycling and Disposal Facility; and

WHEREAS, in August of 2010, an Agreement was finalized between all Affected Municipalities relative to the proposed expansion area; and

WHEREAS, the Affected Municipalities acknowledge, along with the Operator, that the land filling will not expand to the east of South 112th Street; and

WHEREAS, a Conservation Greenbelt area is established east of South 112th Street in the event the DNR approves a further expansion within the Active Fill Area, to facilitate the development of green space for future generations, as well as to provide an effective buffer between current and future land filling operations and the nearby residents; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that the per ton value of the benefits provided in this Agreement are comparable to the benefits being paid by the adjacent Emerald Park Landfill to the west, a professional consultant study concluded that the total value of benefits per ton being provided by Emerald Park is similar to the benefits found in this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the final negotiated agreement provides Racine County, the Town of Norway and the Town of Raymond with Initial and Direct Payments as Affected Municipalities; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that this Agreement is the complete Agreement as to the Northern Footing Active Filling Area and the Active Fill Area pursuant to Wis. Stat. 289.33, between the Affected Municipalities, the Operator, and the Local Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Clerk is directed to transmit certified copies of this resolution to all municipal clerks, to the City of Franklin Clerk and to the Waste Management of Wisconsin, Inc., (WMWI) within seven (7) days after this resolution is adopted.
