WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has created the Transitional Jobs Program which provides opportunities to equip workers with the skills they need to enter the workforce; and

WHEREAS, the Transitional Jobs Project targets residents who are not eligible for working family assistance through the State's W-2 program, including fathers without custody of their children or young adults exiting the foster care system; and

WHEREAS, the program focuses on building partnerships with local organizations to help individuals acquire new skills and work experience; and

WHEREAS, Racine County has been awarded a total of \$568,680.00 from the State of Wisconsin funded by the Recovery Act funds to be disbursed over a multi-year period; and

WHEREAS, Racine County is targeted to receive \$280,019.00 in 2010.
