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RESOLUTION BY THE RACINE COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE TO SUPPORT

RESTORATION AND FLOOD MITIGATION PLAN

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THE HONORABLE MEMBERS of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

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WHEREAS, The Root River Watershed covers approximately 197.6 square miles in Southeast Wisconsin, with approximately 123.66 square miles, or 62.63 percent, of the watershed located within Racine County;

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WHEREAS, The Root River Watershed lies within portions of the City of Racine, the Villages of Caledonia, Mt. Pleasant and Union Grove, and the Towns of Dover, Norway, Raymond and Yorkville;

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WHEREAS, The Root River Watershed has limited fishery and recreational opportunities due to poor water quality, as well as erosion impediment of the Horlick Dam, and sedimentation that has been exacerbated by urban development spanning decades;

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WHEREAS, The economic impacts of poor water quality and limited recreational opportunities such as swimming, boating and significant in this urban area of fishing are Wisconsin;

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WHEREAS, The Root River Watershed in Racine County has also experienced repetitive flood events and related property damage;

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WHEREAS, Various planning efforts have been undertaken in the past 45 years for the Root River Watershed, along with restoration projects to help alleviate and control erosion, sedimentation and pollution in Racine County with the goal of improving Lake Michigan water quality;

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THEREFORE, it is resolved that the Racine County Board of Supervisors and municipal leaders in Racine County will work plan securing resources to create a that offers realistic solutions to the issues of restoration and flood mitigation in the Root River Watershed, that will improve water reductions, quality, including phosphorus and provide citizens of and visitors to Racine County with a renewed and exceptional recreational area for activities such as fishing, swimming and boating.
